The **West End Museum** will host a new photography exhibit in its Members' Gallery that celebrates the beauty and mystery of Italy. Indelebile Italia is part of the Museum's annual commemoration of Italian Heritage Month in October. The exhibit runs from September 22 through November 28. The show reception takes place on October 17 at 4 p.m., when attendees can tour the exhibit and enjoy light refreshments. The exhibit and reception are free and open to the public. The West End Museum is dedicated to the collection, preservation and interpretation of the history and culture of the West End neighborhood. The Museum's permanent exhibit, "The Last Tenement," highlights the immigrant history of the neighborhood through its decimation under Urban Renewal in 1959; two additional galleries feature rotating exhibits.
