The 14th Annual Boston Tattoo Convention

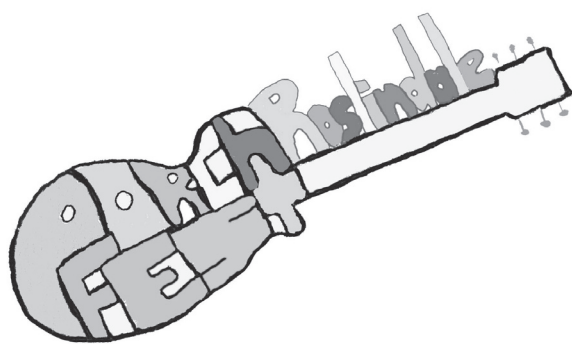
