AN OUTDOOR MUSIC FESTIVAL

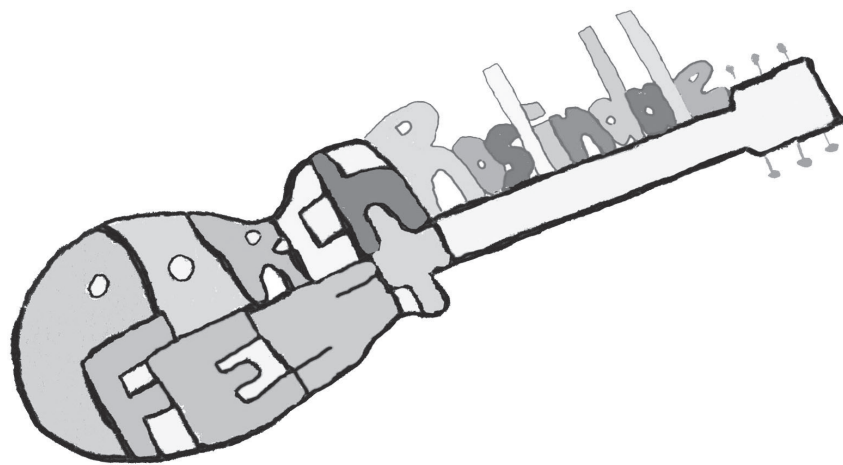

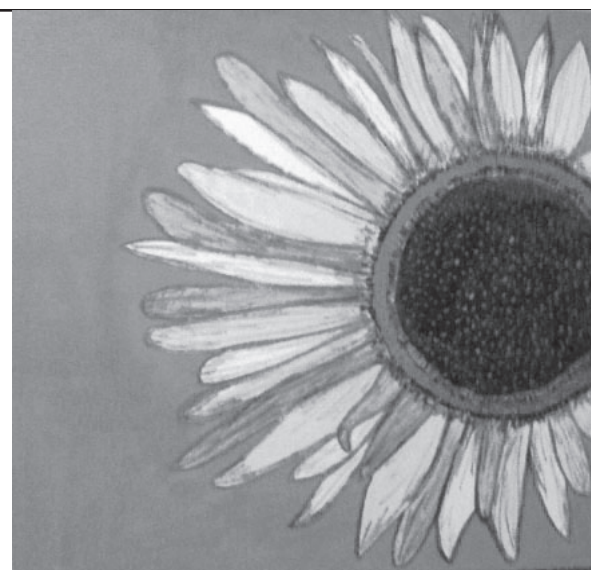


PORCH FEST
